

**Series – Walking in Dominion**

**Class #5 – Standing in the Battle (Final Class)**

**Foundational Scripture: Ephesians 6:11 (KJV), “Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil”**

***Ephesians 6:11 (NLT), “Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies and tricks of the Devil”***

1. We must be ready for potential battle at all times because the enemy can come at anytime. ***1 Peter 5:8, “Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour”***
2. We must expect trials, tribulations and tests to come (**John 16:33**) and we must be dressed for battle. If we attempt to get dressed when the battle comes, it will be too late to gain the advantage and operate in dominion. **STAY ALERT**
3. **Ephesians 6:12-18** – Our uniform:
  - a. The Belt of Truth
  - b. The Breastplate of Righteousness
  - c. Shoes of Preparation of the Gospel of Peace
  - d. Shield of Faith
  - e. Helmet of Salvation
  - f. Sword of the Spirit
4. Before we go out every day, we need to **PUT ON THE ARMOR**. We must confess the Word each day and dress for battle before even leaving the home.
5. All the pieces of spiritual armor flow from the Lord – ***Ephesians 6:10, “Be strong in the Lord and the power of His might”***.
6. We must put on the whole armor by making sure that we “put on” Christ. Jesus becomes our defense – ***Acts 17:28a, “For in Him we live, and move, and have our being.”***
7. We must stand on the truth, not retreat, run or attack (we don't go looking for the devil). We are called to **STAND**. ***Ephesians 6:13, “Wherefore take unto***

*you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand”*

- a. We must stand in His power
  - b. We must stand in His strength
  - c. We must stand in His authority
  - d. While standing, we must pray. Ephesians 6:18, “Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints”.
8. In order to live a victorious, overcoming Christian life and walk in dominion day by day, there are some things that I must do **daily**:
- a. I must receive the Word
  - b. I must take the Word and apply the Word in every area of my life.
  - c. I must practice daily by disciplining myself to do the following **DAILY**:
    - Pray **daily**
    - Meditate **daily**
    - Hear the Word **daily**
    - Speak life **daily** (*monitor the confession of your mouth*)
    - Be slow to speak **daily**
    - Be quick to listen **daily**
    - Be slow to wrath **daily**
    - Put on love **daily** – love for God, love for self, love for others
