Foundational Scripture – Romans 12:1-2

- 1. Common or Uncommon behavior**
 - a. Common: usual, ordinary, customary, habitual, familiar**
 - b. Uncommon: unusual, rare, atypical, unconventional, peculiar**
 - c. Behavior: The way in which someone conducts oneself or behaves, especially towards others**
 - d. John 17:14-19; 1 John 2:15-17; Philippians 3:20**
- 2. Jesus had uncommon behavior. Mark 4:35-41; John 18:1-11**
- 3. Uncommon behavior includes uncommon forgiveness - Matthew 5:21-25; Genesis 50:15-21**
- 4. Uncommon behavior includes uncommon responses - Matthew 5:33-37; 38-42; 43-48; Daniel 3:8-18**
- 5. Uncommon behavior includes uncommon love - Matthew 5:43-48; 1 John 3:16; 1 John 4:7-11**
 - a. We must love based on scripture - 1 Corinthians 13:4-7, “[4] Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. [5] It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. [6] Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. [7] It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.”**
